CBP Makes Online I-94 Application, Payment Available to Travelers Arriving at a Land Port of Entry

U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) announced an enhancement to the I-94 website. This enhancement allows travelers to speed up their entry to the U.S. by applying and paying for their I-94 online. Travelers will need to provide their



biographic and travel information, and pay the \$6 application fee up to seven days prior to their entry. Once complete, they will receive a provisional I-94. In order to finalize the issuance process, they must present themselves at the land port of entry within seven

days of their application and submit biometrics, if applicable, and be interviewed by a CBP officer. Travelers should be prepared to show evidence of their residence, employment, and/or travel plans. If travelers do not complete their I-94 issuances at the land port of entry within seven days, the I-94s will expire and they will be required to reapply and pay the fee again. No refunds will be given if the I-94s are not issued or if travelers are denied entrance.
